Sub: Advisory on not to impose container detention charges on import and export shipments

The Ministry of Public Administration vide its order no. 05.00.0000.173.08.014.07-137 dated 14-05-2020 further extended the period of public holiday/Lockdown untill 30 May 2020.

According to the decision of the meeting held at the conference room of the Department of Shipping's on 17-05-2020 regarding the subject matter with all concerned parties, the para 8 of the advisory note 07/2020 will be replaced as below:

Quote

8. Now therefore, in order to maintain proper supply lines at the Bangladesh seaports, the shipping lines are hereby directed not to impose any container detention/demurrage charge on import and export shipments for the period from 26th March 2020 to 30 May 2020 (both days inclusive) over and above free time arrangement that is currently agreed and availed as part of any negotiated contructual terms. During this period detention/demurrage charges already collected to be adjusted/returned and the shipping lines are also advised not to impose any new or additional charge. This decision is purely a onetime measure to deal with present disruptions caused by spread of COVID-19 Pandemic.
